THOMAS MERTON, SPIRITUAL NOMAD: THREE TALKS

Saturdays 4, 11 and 18 August, 2.30pm

This year marks the 50th anniversary of the death of Thomas Merton, one of the most influential Catholic writers of the 20th century. Merton was a member of the Order of Cistercians of the Strict Observance (OCSO), also known as the Trappists. To mark the anniversary here in Australia, the Cistercians at Tarrawarra Abbey are holding a series of lectures in August with Fr Michael Casey OCSO. Spend an afternoon in the Yarra Valley, discover the work of one of the 20th century's most prominent theologians and mystics, and experience something of Cistercian life today. These are the three topics to be covered by Fr Casey:

Saturday 4 August: The journey to abstraction

Saturday 11 August: Uncovering the deep self

Saturday 18 August: Inner experience and the sense of dread

WALKING WITH JESUS: EMMAUS WALKING RETREAT

Sunday 14 October to Sunday 21 October

The Emmaus Walking Retreat is a seven-day walking retreat in South Gippsland Victoria, from San Remo to Welshpool, hosted by Campion, Kew. The walk takes us along the George Bass coastal walk, Bass Coast rail trail and the Great Southern rail trail. This guided retreat is an opportunity to spend some reflective time walking as a small community. The disciples on the road to Emmaus contemplated their own journey, having walked with Jesus in their lives.
